- Communication and promotion in schools and other institutions at the national level;
- Coordination of activities within the projects (trainings, workshops, camps, activities
 directed towards the adults and young people involved in the Stand by me project)
 and volunteers for the stand by me
- Support the project manager to meet the Stand by Me project targets and the national team to meet the national strategy of the Award in Romania Foundation
- Contribute to the development of the Award program in Romania together with the national team with the possibility to influence the course of the program worldwide;
- Fulfilment of other tasks, the execution of which will be necessary according to the requirements and needs of the employer.
